

Player Of The Year (POTY) Basics

- You have played in POTY tournaments this year starting October 2017.
- In addition to sweeps, you have earned POTY points. (see matrix)
- At the end of the “season”, The top 20 point achievers are invited to a playoff.
- They are reseeded in the same manner and same percentage as the Fed-Ex Cup*
- The Playoff will be played for points also in the same manner and percentage.*
- 50% of the final points come from the series, and 50% from the playoff resulting in Player Of The Year Award*

*New this year to allow the success during the year to be a factor in ultimate award instead of just being a qualifier for the tournament

How are POTY Points Awarded?

How does the new POTY System work?

1. Play and score points throughout the year. (ex. Dennis scored 780)
2. Reseed the top 20 at Fed-Ex tournament reseed percentage with top player = 100% (ex. Dennis at 780 reseeds at 100%, Arnold in second reseeds at 60%, etc)
3. Adjust percentage for ties to give equal amount to each (ex. George and Gary tied at 490 each, the respective percentages at 27% and 22% averaged for both to 25%)
4. YTD Reseed is calculated and points reassigned (ex. Arnold starts with 468 = 60% of 780, etc)
5. Playoff position points will be awarded based on the same distribution so that 50% of awarded points is based on ytd performance, the other 50% based on playoff standing. (ex – max points can be made by only one player, Dennis @1560. However, if Dennis tanks, and the other top players have mediocre rounds and Ken McDougall wins – Ken could readily win with 1110 points.)
